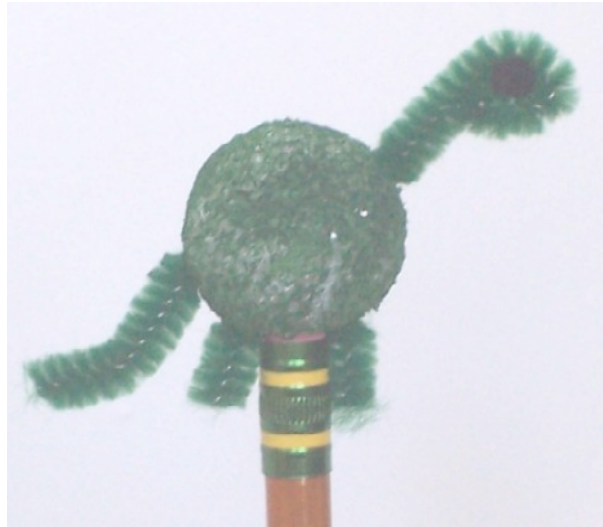


## Dinosaur Pencil-Topper

### Materials:

- (1) 1" plastic foam ball
- (1) green pipe cleaner
- green acrylic paint
- paint brush
- (2) 1/16" black pompoms
- 1 toothpick
- scissors
- pencil



### Instructions:

1. Push the plastic foam ball onto the eraser end of the pencil, then remove ball.
2. Stick the toothpick (so the plastic foam is easier to hold while you paint) anywhere in the ball. Give it a couple of coats of green paint.
3. Cut two 1-inch pieces of pipe cleaner and two  $\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces.
4. Stick the legs (two  $\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces) next to the indent where the eraser goes. See picture for placement.
5. Stick the tail (one-inch pipe cleaner piece) in the end of the ball, curling up the tip.
6. Use the last one-inch pipe cleaner piece and bend one end over to create the head. Stick it into the ball opposite the tail.
7. Glue the 1/16" pompoms onto each side of the head for the eyes.
