

Guess –n- Check Game Questions

The teacher will read each question. After reading each question, you will have two minutes to make your guess and then check. Remember to: understand, plan, solve, and look back.

1. Sandy has 18 marbles. Each marble is either green or blue. There are twice as many green marbles as there are blue marbles. How many blue marbles are there? How many green marbles are there?
2. The fourth grade made \$25.00 on a bake sale. They received only \$5 bills and \$1 bills and collected a total of 9 bills in the moneybag. What combination of bills did they have?
3. Sharon has 6 more pieces of candy than Bill. Together they have 54 pieces of candy. How many pieces of candy does Bill have? How many pieces of candy does Sharon have?
4. Fourth grade had a pet show. There were cats, dogs, and birds. If there were 9 pets in all, and they had 30 legs altogether, how many birds were there in the show?
5. Three students, Bobby, Kim, and Lynn sold raffle tickets for their class. Bobby sold 52 tickets. Kim sold 10 more tickets than Bobby. Lynn sold 10 more tickets than Kim. How many tickets did Kim and Lynn sell?

Answers:

1. 12 green, 6 blue
2. 4 fives, 5 ones
3. Bill has 21 pieces, Sharon has 33 pieces
4. 1 bird
5. Kim sold 62, Lynn sold 72
