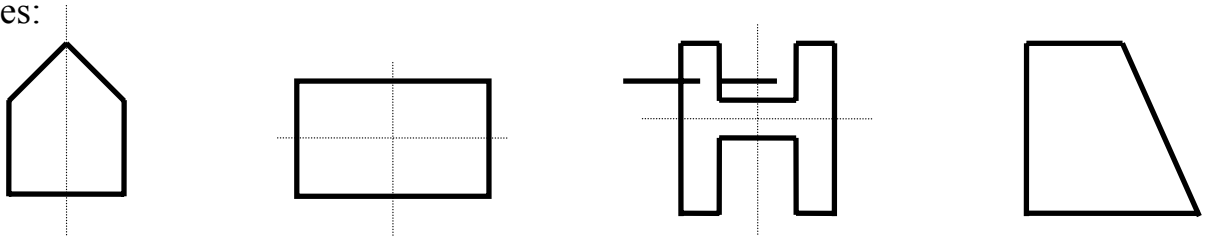


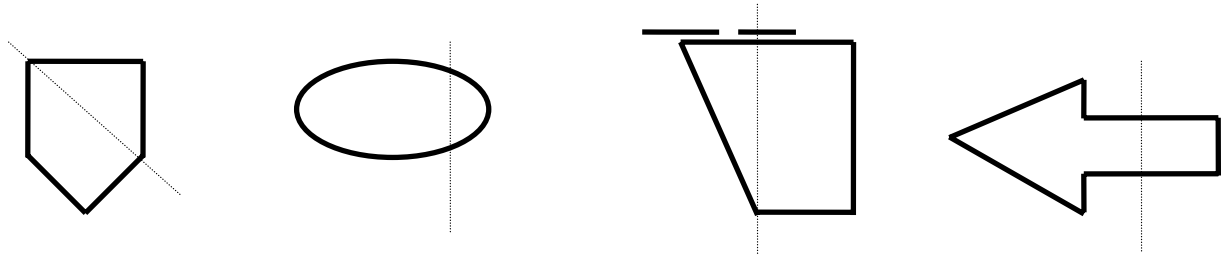
Symmetry

Line of symmetry: When you fold a figure so that the two parts match, the fold line is called line of symmetry. Some figures do not have a line of symmetry. Some figures have more than one line of symmetry.

Examples:



Look at these figures. A line was drawn through them. Notice that the line is not a line of symmetry.



A figure has rotational symmetry if it can rotate less than a full turn around a point to make the figure look the same as it did before the rotation.
