1. Rick and his family are driving 911 miles from Minneapolis to Denver. It is 1012 miles to Seattle. After driving 287 miles, they stopped in Omaha for lunch. How many miles do they have left to drive?

- A. 200 miles
- B. 500 miles
- C. 600 miles
- D. 800 miles

2. Maggie is buying donuts at the bakery for her classmates at school. She wants to buy twice as many donuts as students in her class. Maggie has 18 students in her class. There are 34 classes in the school. About how many donuts should Maggie buy?

- D. 60 donuts

3. Latasha collects pennies, in August she collected 1,300 pennies, in September she collected 800 pennies, for October she collected 590 pennies, in November she collected 610 pennies, and in December she collected 995 pennies. About how many pennies did Latasha collect in September and October?
